

## ABOUT THE SPEAKERS:



**María Rosa Lojo** is the academic director of the Centre of Critical Studies of Argentine Literature in the University of Salvador. She is also one of the most prominent Argentine authors. Her book *Las libres del Sur* (2013) deals with Victoria Ocampo and her milieu. The book has been translated into English and is currently being translated into Bangla by Abdullah Rafique-um-Munir Chowdhury.

**Abdullah Rafique-um-Munir Chowdhury** teaches Spanish and Translation Studies at Institute of Modern Languages, University of Dhaka. He is an award-winning translator, writer and editor with ten-something books to his name. His translations (from Spanish and English into Bangla) include fiction, non-fiction and poetry. He is currently translating *Las libres del Sur* into Bangla.



**Shyama Prasad Ganguly** is former Professor of JNU in Spanish and Latin American studies (1978-2012) specialising in Economic and Comparative culture studies. He has done pioneering work on Tagore's reception in Spain/Latin America and (Cervantes') *El Quijote* in India. He has authored, edited, translated 26 books and numerous articles on Spanish and Latin American themes. He has served as interpreter and has been involved in serious theatre for six decades.
